Deep listening

Natural Circuits is an intimate musical storytelling experience that invites the audience to slow down, reflect, and reconnect. Inspired by the infinite cycles of nature, the performance explores themes of gratitude, resilience, and interconnectedness through sound.

Across a 45-minute session, I guide the audience through a journey of sound, storytelling, and spoken word—interlacing live looping, field recordings, poetry, and organic textures. The music evokes worldly soundscapes that blend natural and electronic elements, creating a mindful, immersive experience that inspires healing reflections on our relationship with ourselves, our communities, and the environment.

I am a Chilean-born performer and producer based in Melbourne. I graduated from Escuela Moderna de Música in Santiago, where I studied with some of Chile's most respected teachers, before touring internationally with cruise-ship showbands from 2012 to 2018.
